- My name is Mitchell Harrison, and I am a resident of Cherokee County Georgia. I am a college student, but also work for the Georgia Republican party as a Field Organizer. I am over the age of 18 and make these statements based on my personal knowledge of the facts, matters and events described herein.
- 2. As part of my assignment with the Georgia Republican panity. I was to motiter balled constrained and processing final forecasts, in the Georgia Republican panity and section selection of the Politan elections office located at 3155 English Street in Albana. There I met with Bereiche Mohy, the Regional Field Bereiche. Execution assigned Michelle Bereinson and I to go descrete the countier of destinete and millimy balled at the State Frame are location in diseases the Countier of destinetes and millimy balled at the State Frame are location in diseases the Countier of States and Albana. I understood that Michelle and I were to be involved in Closely monitoring the ballet countier monitor.

- 4. The room where the ballot processing took place is a very large room and there were at least 25 employees working there, I am not sure of the exact number. Michelle and I noted that Robb Pitts, the Chairman of the Fulton County Commission was in the counting room and stayed there

room area, and he actually spoke with us briefly.

- 5. It was frustraine during the time Michelle and I were there because we were kept so isolated from where the ballot processing and counting activity was actually taking place. The location and layout of the observation area, inorically, made it difficult to observe much that was going on in the ballot counting area.
- 6. For example, the machine that copied the UOCAVA electronically received ballots (sometimes called military ballots) onto aper copies could only be wiesed from the side and the doon to that area were positioned in a way that prevented us from any viewing of this process. Additionally, the scanners that scenae the absentee ballots were not visible to us at all.
- 7. The only way we knew that the scanners were located across this large room and was that Regina Walter, Public Affairs Manager for Liections spoke to us at one point and she described the process to Michelle and to me. There were several different news crews that came and went that evening from this same observation area.
- 6. Sometime after 10 Crickok p.m., the counting activity sizewed, butty afferwards, a younger day with long braised but bland hair yelled out to all of them they should stop working and come about homerow (the next day, well-indext) forwering 4-fall at 8-bit AA. Thereafter, all but 4 election employees this State Farm, kening just the blood haired lady (also Michelle and I assumed was the supervisor), their lades and Regina Waller at the location. This lady had apparent through the eight and Michelle and Identificated her to be the supervisor.
- 9. Another trail we had been given by franction was to inquire how many ballots had been processed and how many were fill let be go, the good these questions of legis Walter, the public Affairs Manager for Decisions. 10. After concluding that Regina Waller would not give us this information on the number processed versus the ones still left to be processed, we along with the Fox News crew left the

When arrived at the same observation area, there was no one counting habitots. Again we were toolt that those counting the ballots had "your finished" and that there had been about 5 people them. Trevial and I Dought that was odd because at 10.00 P.M., Region Waller and the supervisor lady had said they were done counting for the night, and would not resume until 8.30 A.M. On most morning.
