

HOW BALLOTS ARE COUNTED IN MONO COUNTY

MAILED BALLOTS RECEIVED BY NOV. 3RD

Mailed ballots are checked in, signatures and addresses verified and voting credit is given to prevent a second ballot being counted for a voter. These votes will be included in the first election results report on Election Night.

ELECTION DAY NOV. 3RD

After votes are cast at the polling location on Election Day, they are securely transported to the Mono County Elections Office in Bridgeport for counting. All votes cast in person are included in the last elections results report on Election Night. Voting credit is given to all in-person voters, to prevent a second ballot being counted for the same voter.

MAILED BALLOTS POSTMARKED OR RECEIVED ON NOV. 3RD

Mailed ballots dropped of at a polling location or drop box on Nov. 3rd by 8:00 p.m. or postmarked and received by the deadline are checked in and all signatures and addresses are verified. Once confirmed that the voter has not already voted, these ballots can be added to the election results total.

PROVISIONAL AND CONDITIONAL BALLOTS

After all other ballots are counted, every provisional and conditional ballot is checked to ensure that the voter has not voted anywhere in California. If the voter is eligible to vote, and has not already voted, these votes are added to the final elections result total.
