We were looking at the contest preview report to evaluate these changes. We did notice the voter nom contest at 3 markers, I believe they are fine and the party prefs are good at the 8 point font.

The contest I mentioned below have some occupations at 7 points and or wrapping to another line and they look a little tight. My supervisors would like all occupations set to 8 point so those contest will probably need to be set at 3 markers to fit properly. In addition they would like all candidate names set to 9 points, its what we used with the previous system. If the write in language will fit like that they would like that to be set across all contest to keep consistency on the ballot.

We are almost done proofing the reports and are getting changes together and will get them up to you as soon as we have them all compiled.

We have been talking about the single marker for the presidential contest and want to know if we can have the write in language stacked like the example below and no line, just the blank space. This is an 8 point font, no bolding, line spacing set to exactly 8 points.

Also the team here would like to have the write in detection setting set to Voting Target or Write-in Area

We also noticed a few contest with ballot designations running long and the font being sized down and others just being crowded because of the wrapping. We would like the following changes:

All contest

- Candidate names set to 9 point font
- Ballot Designations 8 point for both English and Spanish

The ballot designation font size change will mean the following contest will need to go to 3 markers

- Dem Central Committee Assembly 47
- Rep Central Committee District 4
- Chaffey CCD Area 3
- Chaffey CCD Area 5

We might need to adjust a few more but want to see if dropping the candidate name font size helps those.

We also had to change the voting instructions, please see the attached document for the changes in both languages.
