

Hi all,

Since last Thursday counties have forced a match on another 3,360 additional voter pairs. That's 48,533 total since the beginning of the year!

That said there are still over 17.7k remaining potential matches identified (with our 4 match sets below) for counties for review. As counties are sending VBM ballots to voters it is strongly recommended to review these matches prior to extracting or prior to mailing VBMs to avoid sending matching voters duplicate ballots. If you have already extracted your mailing lists take what steps are possible to align VBM mailing to accommodate for matches determined prior to mailing. If you have already mailed these then matching and merging these will enable us to catch any potential double voting scenarios moving forward.

The below chart shows the counts of matches identified today with the four criteria sets we are using to find additional matches not identified in VoteCal. This shows which ones are newly identified this week vs. those that were provided last Thursday or in prior weeks.



The County request:

- Please review these potential matches and "force a match" on those you are confident are the same voter, and complete any resulting Merge Voter Determine Survivor (MVDS) messages. Please skip over those you believe are different voters (likely twins given the match criteria), record these non-matches and send them my way.
- Please respond to let me know if you have been able to keep up with weekly email requests on this topic and/or if you have any questions.
 - o If your county has kept up with all prior weekly email requests you may limit your attention to the "Newly identified" voter record pairs and we'll assume that all the previously provided pairs have been

determined to not match. If your county has not keep up with all prior weekly emails on this topic please work all "Previously provided" and "Newly identified" voter record pairs.

If you have already extracted your mailing lists take what steps are possible to align VBM mailing to accommodate for matches determined prior to mailing.
