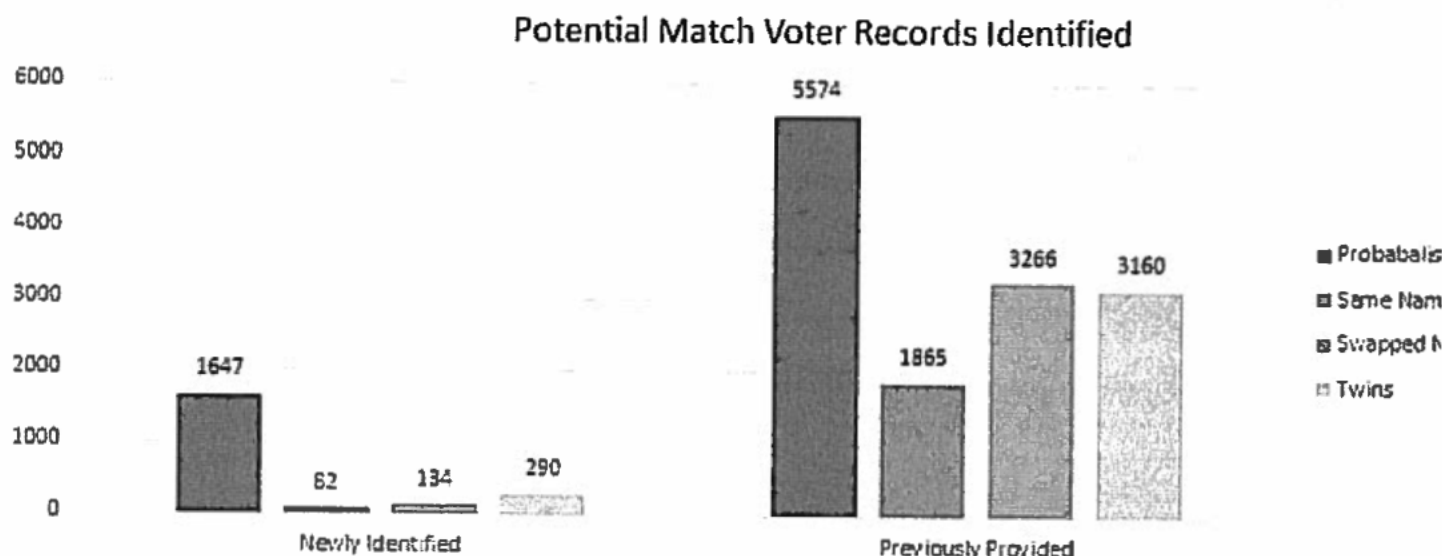

Hi all,
Since last Thursday counties have forced a match on another 1,957 additional voter pairs. That's 54,152 total since the beginning of the year.
That said there are still over 16k potential matches identified (down from 16.1k last week) for counties to review. It is strongly recommended to review these matches to prevent the potential for counting votes twice for the same voter. Counties, please see updated instructions below in highlight.

The below chart shows the counts of matches identified today with the four criteria sets we are using to find additional matches not identified in VoteCal. This shows which ones are newly identified this week vs. those that were provided last Thursday or in prior weeks.



The County request:

1. Please open the attachment and filter the "10-8-2020 Voter Match Pairs" tab on column F "Voter County" to your county. **DO NOT filter column G "Matching Voter County" or you will avoid working cross county voter pairs identified.**
2. Please review these potential matches and "force a match" on those you are confident are the same voter, and complete any resulting Merge Voter Determine Survivor (MVDS) messages. Please skip over those you believe are different voters (Ex: twins), record these non-matches and send them my way.
3. Please respond to let me know if you have been able to keep up with weekly email requests on this topic and/or if you have any questions.

- o If your county has kept up with all prior weekly email requests you may limit your attention to the "Newly Identified" voter record pairs and we'll assume that all the previously provided pairs have been determined to not match. If your county has not keep up with all prior weekly emails on this topic please work all "Previously provided" and "Newly identified" voter record pairs.

Hi all,

Since last Thursday counties have forced a match on another **3,088** additional voter pairs. That's **52,743** total since the beginning of the year!

That said there are still over 16.1k potential matches identified (down from 17.3k last week) for counties to review. It is strongly recommended to review these matches to avoid sending duplicate ballots and/or prevent the potential for counting votes twice for the same voter.

The below chart shows the counts of matches identified today with the four criteria sets we are using to find additional matches not identified in VoteCal. This shows which ones are newly identified this week vs. those that were provided last Thursday or in prior weeks.
