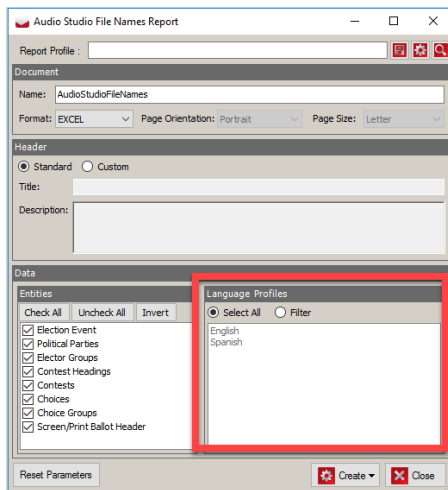
AUDIO STUDIO

Import all audio types at one time

Audio Studio can be used to import human recorded or synthesized audio (independent of EED). Users are now able to import all audio types for a given contest at one time, including:

- Contest Names,
- Review Titles and
- Proposition text,

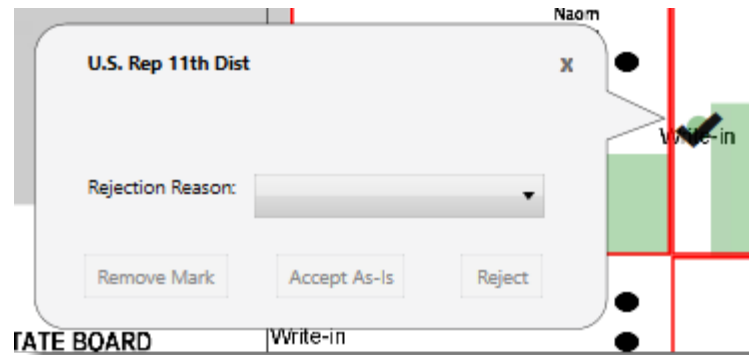
This will allow for bulk import of all contest elements by object type and language.

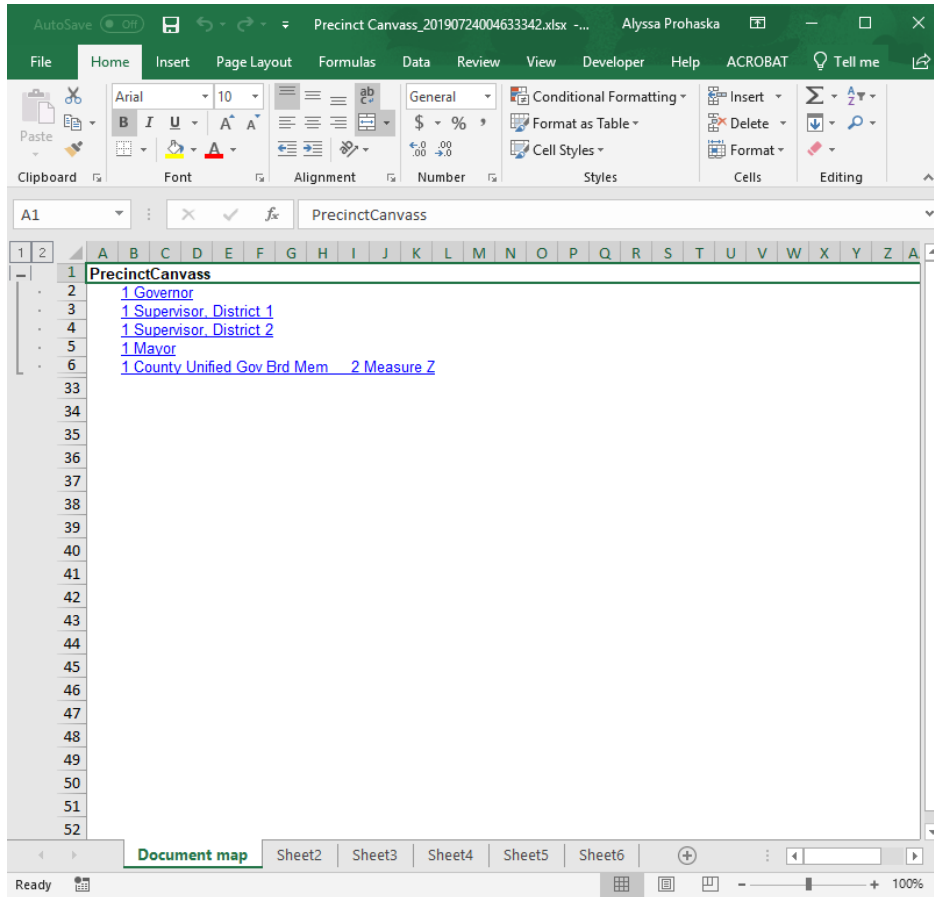
